

## OTELP INITIATIVES IN COMBATING DIARRHEA SITUATION IN LANJIGARH, KALAHANDI, ORISSA, INDIA

27 Health camps and awareness programmes (including 10 diarrhea camps) were organized by Facilitating NGO (FNGO) Gramin Vikas Trust (GVT) in association with Maa Santoshi Janakalyan Foundation Hospital, Bankakundru, Lanjigarh, on 25th June, 2009, much before the spreading of diarrhoea.



1416 families of 40 Phase-I villages were treated and medicines worth Rs. 1.08 lakhs were distributed through different Camps.

Awareness on different hygienic practices were made during the health camps. Honorable MLA of Lanjigarh visited the health camps and advised them to continue the support.



The Coordinator of Maa Santoshi Janakalyan Foundation Hospital, Bankakundru while appreciating the efforts of FNGO GVT says, “the present death toll would be much more in absence of such pre-health camps.”

Awareness campaign on health and sanitation in all the Programme Villages of Phase-II OTELP were initiated by FNGO Gram Vikas since past few months. One emergency diarrhea camp was organized by Gram Vikas with Doctors and Assistants from Kalyansingpur immediately after 1<sup>st</sup> death at Ghatikundru village of Pahadpadar GP in Lanjigarh block on 16.08.09. Out of 116 patients, 23 diarrhoea patients were treated and their lives were saved.

After getting initial information from Gram Vikas, the Government Medical Teams started their action.

Thereafter, 4 health camps were organized by Gram Vikas involving Doctors and other staff from Bhawanipatna covering 467 families of 11 villages of Phase-II area. During the camps medicines worth Rs. 30, 000.00 were distributed to the patients. Also 350 kgs of *Chura* (Flattened Rice) and sugar, packaged drinking water etc. were supplied in the affected areas.

While the epidemic has spread to more villages, mass campaign on health and hygiene practices have been started by using vehicles and loudspeakers. The FNGO functionaries are regularly informing about incidences of diarrhea to local Health Centers at Bengaon and Bankakundru.

FNGO staffs of OTELP have started massive campaigns and are constantly motivating village youths, SHG members to keep their surrounding clean and to maintain the hygiene practices.

FNGO functionaries of Lanjigarh block have started ensuring continuous supply of boiled water to each household in the villages (*also halogenated wherever available*) since 04.08.09, involving community mobilisers, village volunteers and SHG members.

**The Samad, Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2009**  
Kalyansingpur (18/8): Six persons have died and 23 persons are affected in diarrhea in last four days in Ghatikundur village of Lanjigarh Block of Kalahandi district adjoining to Kalyansingpur Block. It is gathered from the incidence that on 13<sup>th</sup> of August, 09 the Sanasena Majhi (60) died in diarrhea. Further, Tulasi Majhi (20), Pana Majhi (22), Jajati Majhi (35), Anki Majhi (20) and Kia Harizan (16) died. The people of NGO Gram Vikas reached first in the village and distributed medicines to the people and informed about the incidence to the district health department. With the leadership of Mr. A.K. Rath, CDMO, Kalahandi a team of doctors have provided required treatment to the affected people. Mr. Sanjay Ku. Nahak, FNGO Representative informed that flattened rice and Jaggery have been distributed by Gram Vikas. To have a control over the diarrhea in that locality Gram Vikas has started distributing free medicines. Sri Pradip Mohanty, Sri Bhanja Babu along with other 16 staff are supporting the above activities.

Additional Mobility Support has been faciliated from OTELP to Chief District Medical Officer (CDMO), Kalahandi since 24.08.09 to mobilize different medical teams to epidemic areas for treatment.
